

Summary Results of Annistown's Title I Parent Survey

2009-2010

One hundred and thirty Annistown parents participated in the survey. The majority of parents are aware that our school receives Title I funds and services and that the school communicates with them on a regular basis. Parents would like to receive information from school by way of the student newsletter, e-mail and the automated phone system. Eighty percent of parents stated that the school has given them a copy of the Title I documents and has explained them to them. Parents have shown their involvement this year by attending Parent Center workshops, PTA meetings, and Parent/Teacher conferences. This showed an increase of parent participation over last year. Parents indicated that the parent center hours were convenient but would like to see workshops offered after school and on Saturdays. A goal for the Title I committee is to look at this issue and discuss the possibility of more flexible meeting times for workshops. Parents stated that they would like more workshops in the areas of math, reading, writing and social issues. Parents would like to see the Parent Center purchase more educational games in math and reading and workbooks. A goal for the Parent Center is to provide more resources in these areas.
