ment showing proof of birth date. 2) **Evidence of vision, hearing, and dental exams,** 3) *A Georgia certificate of immunization,* 4) Proof of residency in the attendance zone, 5) Proof of custody/guardianship, if not the birth parent, 6) The child's social security number.
