Mentoring program for drop outs

The leadership team will work to create a cadre of mentors to work with students who have dropped out, withdrawn, and/or been unsuccessful in a past minisemester. The mentor will meet with the student to discuss performance and progress on a weekly basis.

A school contact will be made to each student who has been withdrawn and/or dropped from a class. Based on the reason for the withdrawal a plan of action will be developed to address the needs of this student to get said student re enrolled.
