Implementation Design

Collaboration and Conversation

Teachers and staff members will work in collaborative teams to plan strategies and coordinate lessons to ensure optimal learning opportunities for students.

SD: MATH INSTITUTE - ELEMENTARY

The Math Institute provides effective professional learning through modeling by "master" teachers, peer coaching, and debriefing discussions. Following the summer workshop, ongoing mentoring and implementing of best practices should be evident.

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SD: Using COACHES to Improve Student Achievement

Instructional Coaches at Chattahoochee Elementary School have been trained to work with individual teachers and teacher groups. These coaches will work with individual teachers to collaborate about effective instruction, and the coaches will work with grade levels to use protocols to manage effective conversation and use of time.

SD: Vertical Team Discussions at Chattahoochee Elementary

Each month, members of the Math Vertical Team will discuss effective math instruction and collaborate with their grade levels to re-deliver the information.

Implementing Guided Math

During Collaborative Learning meetings, the Math Coach will provide effective strategies for math instruction.

SD: Collaboration and Communication

Teachers will work in collaborative teams to plan strategies and coordinate lessons to ensure optimal learning opportunities for students.

SD: Implementing Effective Math Strategies

Teachers will learn effective math strategies to help improve student achievement.

Incorporating Effective CQI Instruction

At the beginning of the school day, Chattahoochee Elementary will incorporate Continuous Quality Improvement strategies to enrich and remediate for math. All staff members are considered "math teachers", and all staff members will be expected to assist during this time.

SD: Planning for Effective Instruction during CQI

Each week, grade levels will plan effective instruction for CQI. Targeted skills will be identified through data analysis of interim assessments, local assessments, etc.

Annual Objective

Implementation Design

Collaboration about AKS and Common Core

Weekly planning meetings will focus on implementing the AKS and Common Core in all subject areas.

SD: Collaborative Planning Meetings - Weekly Discussions

Chattahoochee Elementary staff will meet at least one time per week to review instructional calendars and pacing guides. During this meeting lesson plans and appropriate strategies to effectively teach the AKS and Common Core objectives will be discussed.

SD: SUMMER LITERACY INSTITUTE

An intensive course in the theory and practice of Readers' and Writers' Workshop in K-12 language arts and literacy strategies for math, science, and social studies.

SD: VISION CONFERENCE SERIES

Two three-hour sessions (separate from each other), each with an invited national consultant to discuss key issues related to literacy and its effective teaching in our classrooms.

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Continued Work with Reading and Writing Workshops

We will continue to provide staff development for teachers in effective strategies during Reading and Writing Workshop.

SD: Effective Implementation of Reading and Writing Workshops

During collaborative planning meetings, the Literacy Coach and Reading Specialist will provide continued training of effective practices in the Workshop models. Observations and videos will be used to highlight best practices.

SD: Increasing EXCEEDS in Writing

We will continue staff development for all teachers in helping our students to meet the Exceeds standards in writing.

Vertical Team Discussions with Instructional Coaches

Our Instructional Coaches will work with Vertical Team members to create instructional capacity within the school.

SD: 2012/2013 Math and Science Staff Development Training

Year-long training (10 hours total) that provides teachers with a focus on support of newly aligned AKS content and quality instructional practice in Math, and infusion of Technology, Inquiry, Differentiation, and Engagement (T.I.D.E.) in Science instruction to improve technical literacy, problem-solving skills, and student achievement.

SD: COACHES - Providing coaching support for Effective Instruction

Chattahoochee Elementary COACHES will provide support, encouragement, and mentorship for teachers. These instructional coaches have been trained in working with individual teachers and groups of teachers to use protocols for effective use of time.

SD: Vertical Team meetings

Each month, teachers will assemble with Vertical Team representatives to discuss instructional strategies for all content areas. After the meetings, staff members will be expected to re-deliver the information to grade levels.
