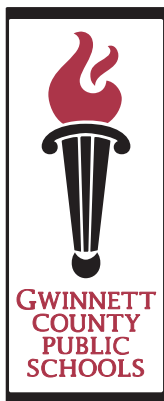

2012 Intel International Science and Engineering Fair: Parkview HS student collects two awards for science research

Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS) student Aprotim “Cory” Bhowmik is starting his summer break as a big winner after collecting two awards during the recent Intel International Science and Engineering Fair. Cory, a 15-year old rising 11th grader at **Parkview High**, competed in the Medicine and Health Sciences category with his project titled *Arterial Hemodynamics in Atherosclerosis Patients*. He was selected for the following two special awards:

- The American Physiological Society’s (APS) 1st Award

The American Physiological Society (APS) is a nonprofit organization devoted to fostering education, scientific research, and dissemination of information in the physiological sciences. As recipient of the organization’s 1st Award, Cory received a cash award of \$1,500, a certificate, a t-shirt, and a one-year subscription to APS publications.

- Grand Awards: Medicine and Health Sciences - Presented by Intel, 3rd Award

As recipient of a 3rd Award in the category of Medicine and Health Sciences, for Best in Category, Cory received a monetary award for \$1,000.

The international event was held in Pittsburgh in mid-May where Cory competed with students from around the globe. He was one of three Gwinnett students invited to compete at the international competition after earning first place at the state level event in April where his project was also selected as one of the top 10 in Georgia.
