## **18 Gwinnett schools recognized for student achievement**

A total of 18 Gwinnett County schools were recognized today by the Governor's Office of Student Achievement, in collaboration with the Governor's Office, and the Georgia Department of Education, for improving and promoting excellence in student academic achievement. The recognition is part of the Single Statewide Accountability System (SSAS), which recognizes Georgia schools for their continuous improvement in raising student achievement and closing achievement gaps.

The number of Gwinnett schools on this year's list is evidence of the teaching and learning that takes place in Gwinnett's classrooms. "Our teachers and administrators are focused on helping each student achieve Gwinnett's rigorous and challenging Academic Knowledge and Skills (AKS) curriculum standards." says **Dr. Cindy Loe**, associate superintendent of teaching and learning. "This commitment to high expectations for all students has resulted in greater achievement and a narrowing of the achievement gap. Gwinnett students can be confident that by mastering Gwinnett's AKS, they will be prepared to meet and exceed the state's testing goals, and compete with the best and brightest students from around the world."

The state recognizes schools in two categories: 1) Highest Performance, indicating the percentage of students meeting and exceeding academic standards; and 2) Greatest Gains, indicating the greatest gain in percentage of students meeting and exceeding academic standards. In each category, there are four school award levels: Platinum, Gold, Silver, and Bronze.

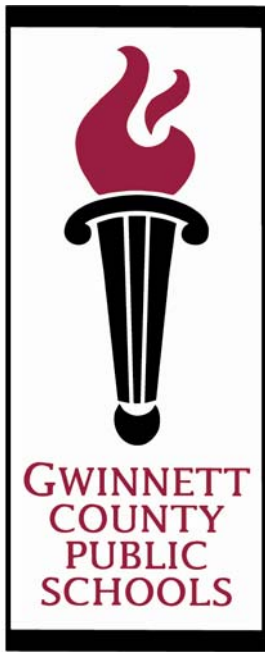
