Meetings are typically held on the second Thursday of each month in the Board Room at Lawrenceville East, 723 Hi-Hope Road in Lawrenceville. Each month, the Board of Education's regular meeting begins at 7 p.m. A 30-minute public forum for persons not on the agenda begins at 6:30 p.m. All meetings, except executive sessions, are open to the public.

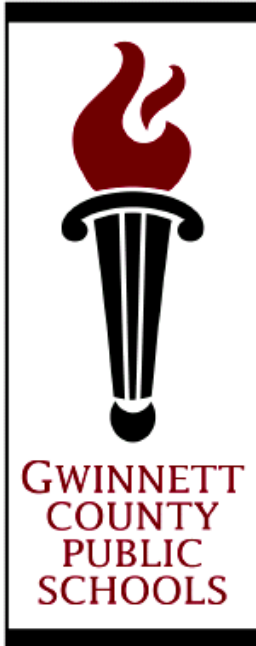
