

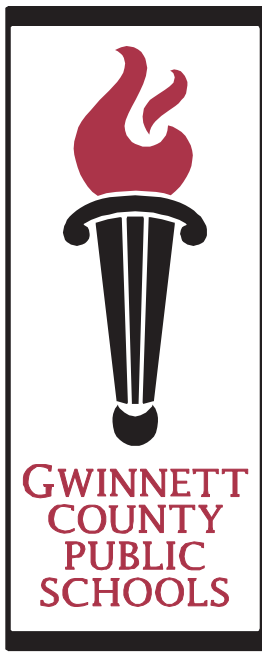

Principals appointed for North Gwinnett HS and Dacula ES

At a called meeting on July 31, the **Gwinnett County Board of Education** named principals for two schools—North Gwinnett High and Dacula Elementary. Both vacancies occurred as the result of principal appointments to system level leadership positions. (Earlier this month, former North Gwinnett High Principal Dr. John Green was named an Area Superintendent, and Dr. Paul Brooksher, formerly the principal of Dacula Elementary, was appointed as a Human Resources Area Staffing Director.) With the transition of Green and Brooksher to the district level, the School Board appointed **Ed Shaddix** as **North Gwinnett High's** principal and **Mary Lou Enright** as the principal for **Dacula Elementary**. Both of these appointments are effective immediately.
