Objective: Nesbit Elementary School will increase academic performance in Mathematics for all students with a focus on Students With Disabilities (SWD), English Language Learners (ELL), Hispanic and Black/African American subgroups to meet and/or exceed baseline targets through Math Specialists, guided math instruction, peer coaching, staff development focusing on quality teaching practices, the use of exemplars and problem solving.

Objective: Nesbit Elementary School will increase academic performance in Reading and Language Arts for all students with a focus on the English Language Learners (ELL), Native American and Students With Disabilities (SWD) subgroups to meet and/or exceed annual targets through collaborative planning in Professional Learning Communities, targeted interventions, use of Reader's and Writer's Workshop, vocabulary development and through enhanced book studies.

Objective: Nesbit Elementary School will increase academic performance in Science for all students so that students will increase the mean score on the CRCT for AYP Reporting through collaborative planning in Professional Learning Communities, targeted interventions, the use of a Science Special, vocabulary development and through team teaching.
