Early release days are held twice a year in elementary and middle schools to allow for parent-teacher conferences. School is dismissed 2 1/2 hours early.

The calendar has been revised to note the two flood days taken in September and to designate two additional snow days.

- First flood day (Sept. 21) missed— Make up on Feb. 12;
Second flood day (Sept. 22) missed— Make up on March 15;

With the possibility of more inclement weather during the winter months, GCPS has designated two additional snow days, for a total of three snow make-up days for the rest of the school year.

- First day (Jan. 8) missed— Make up on Feb. 15 (added 10/09);
Second day missed— Make up on April 2 (added 10/09);
Third day missed— Make up on May 27.

Unused snow make-up days will be student holidays.

If bad weather causes school to be cancelled or dismissed early, public announcements will be made on GCPS TV, on the school system's web site (www.gwinnett.k12.ga.us), and via metro-Atlanta radio and television stations.

Snow Make-up Days: *The calendar has been revised to note the two flood days taken in September and to designate two additional snow days.* If school is cancelled for inclement weather, students and staff will make up additional days as follows: First day missed, make up on **Feb. 15**; second day missed, make up on **April 2**; and third day missed, make up on **May 27**. Unused snow make-up days will be student holidays. Throughout the school year, teachers are scheduled to work 10 planning/staff development days. If Snow Make-up Day 3 is needed, post-planning days would shift accordingly. Should a planned day be pre-empted by inclement weather or by the need to use a snow make-up day, then the planned day would be added to the end of the school calendar, following post-planning days. **Required Teacher Planning/Staff Development Days:** August 5–7, January 4, March 12, and May 27 and 28.
