## **Berkmar High to defend title on GCPS TV**

**Gwinnett County Public Schools Television** (GCPS TV) is the station to watch for a play-by-play of **Berkmar High** defending its title as Gwinnett’s Readers Rally Champion. The final round took place in front of the cameras at the GCPS TV Broadcast Center located at the school system’s Instructional Support Center (ISC) in Suwanee. The competition, determining the winners at each level, was recorded and will air from Tuesday, Feb. 22, through Sunday, Feb. 27, at 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. on GCPS TV.

Berkmar High came out on top once again and kept its title as districtwide winner for 2011. This year’s other two level winners are **Osborne Middle** and **Minor Elementary**. Below are scores from the semifinals and final rounds of competition.
