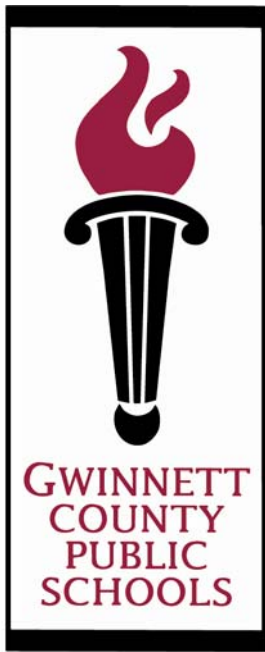
The program areas include:
