A team of **Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS)** students from **Parkview High** recently returned home to Georgia bearing one more national title--- 1st place winners in the Music Production category during the 2011 National Technology Students' Association (TSA) Conference.

Parkview High students who participate in the school's Technology Student Association chapter attended the 2011 National TSA conference held at the Gaylord Texan Resort & Convention Center in Grapevine, Texas, June 21-25. Under the leadership of Parkview High teacher and TSA advisor **Mr. Terry Cotton**, the Parkview High TSA students placed in three events--- Technology Bowl Oral, Architectural Model, and Music Production. They competed against approximately 4,000 students. The Parkview High song entitled "We Are TSA!" placed 1st nationally in the Music Production event.
